Guidelines for admission 2019 – 2020

Admission from abroad

You may be admitted to Wolfert Bilingual if:

- you speak Dutch well (near-native level),
- you can prove that you are capable of havo or vwo level studies. Wolfert Bilingual
 offers the opportunity to take a NIO test (*Nederlands Intelligentietest voor*Onderwijsniveau a Dutch intelligence test to determine educational level),
- you have a positive written recommendation from your previous school,
- your subject choice is compatible with the subject choices offered by Wolfert Bilingual,
- you and your parents have attended an intake interview at the school.

Admission to havo 4

You may be admitted to havo 4 if:

- you have a mavo/vmbo-tl diploma or similar proof of achievement,
- you have a positive written recommendation from your previous school,
- your final grades for the core subjects (Dutch, English and Maths) are a 7 or higher,
- you have a sufficiently high level of German, French or Spanish (applies only to the CM profile),
- your subject choice is compatible with the subject choices offered by Wolfert Bilingual,
- you and your parents have attended an intake interview at the school.

Admission to vwo 5

You may be admitted to vwo 5 if:

- you have a havo diploma or similar proof of achievement,
- you have a positive written recommendation from your previous school,
- your final grades for the core subjects (Dutch, English and Maths) are a 7 or higher,
- you have studied a modern foreign language to a sufficiently high level (in addition to English), and you have achieved sufficiently high grades in enough subjects,
- your profile and subject choice are compatible with the profile and subject choices offered by Wolfert Bilingual,
- you and your parents have attended an intake interview at the school.
